Current Situation

We are expecting a cooling trend with temperatures in the 90's. Overnight we will see a cool marine layer that will begin to move farther inland each evening, keeping the fire quiet during the night. We will use ground resources and helicopters to directly engage in areas that are burning in the southern, southwestern, and northeastern perimeter of the incident. Engine crews will continue to mop up and secure areas around the perimeter of the fire.

Evacuations: - As of 12 pm on Saturday, all evacuation orders have been lifted.

<u>Closures</u>: Four National Forests (NF) in California remain closed, including the Los Padres NF. These decisions will continue to be reviewed daily, taking fire and weather conditions into account by the Regional Forester.

The Nacimiento-Ferguson Road is closed to all traffic from Highway 1 to the Fort Hunter Liggett base boundary line. For more information visit https://roads.dot.ca.gov/
